How to play Platinum Roulette Single Zero

PLATINUM ROULETTE SINGLE ZERO RULES

Platinum Roulette Single Zero is a classic casino game consisting of a wheel partitioned into the numbers 0-36, and a table on which to place bets. Numbers 1-36 on the wheel are coloured red or black, while the 0 is green.

Bets may be placed on the 0 (zero) or on any number between 1-36.

When a game is played, the wheel spins and a small white ball is released.

The ball eventually settles on one of the numbers 0, or 1-36 and this will be the winning number.

Bets are placed on the table before the wheel is spun, and these bets can be placed on a variety of different outcomes.

GAME CONTROLS

CHIP VALUE: To select a chip value, click on the chip value you wish to play. Through the active arrows on the left and right side of the chips, additional chip values can be selected.

PLACE A BET: After a chip value is selected click on the betting area to place or increase a bet. You can place a bet on any of the active betting fields. Every click on a betting area adds a chip of the selected value to your bet. The bet amount may be increased by adding another chip to the betting area. By pointing at different positions on the table, the possible bet types correlated to a specific position will appear in a highlight.

DOUBLE: Select "Double" to double your current bet.

CLEAR: Select "Clear" to remove all bets from the table.

SPIN: Click on "Spin" to play the round by spinning the wheel.

REBET & SPIN: Click on "Rebet and Spin" to place the same bet as in the previous round and to automatically spin the wheel again.

DOUBLE & SPIN: Click on "Double and Spin" to place doubled the bet made in the previous round and to automatically spin the wheel again.

NEW BET: Click on "New Bet" to place a new bet.

It is possible to spin the wheel without placing any bets. This will not deduct any amount of the player's balance.

There is a maximum limit for the whole table equal to the biggest stake available.

RACETRACK BETS:

Racetrack bets are one or more bets on a series of numbers as they appear on the roulette wheel. Some racetrack bets have a predefined minimum number of chips that are required to place the bets. Racetrack bets are made by placing chips directly on the roulette racetrack.

Number and Neighbors: a bet type that consists of five simultaneous straight wagers of equal value on 5 numbers – 1 number plus the 2 numbers on its left side and the 2 numbers on its right side. Pays 35 to 1. To make a Number and Neighbors bet, place a chip on a number located on the racetrack, that is the center number of the five adjacent numbers you wish to bet on.

Jeu Zero: a bet on a series of 7 numbers – 12, 35, 3, 26, 0, 32, 15. To make this bet, place a chip on the area of the racetrack labeled "Jeu 0".

Tiers: a bet on a series of 12 numbers – 27, 13, 36, 11, 30, 8, 23, 10, 5, 24, 16, 33. To make this bet, place a chip on the area of the racetrack labeled "Tiers".

Orphelins: a bet on 2 series of 8 numbers total – 17, 34, 6 and 1, 20, 14, 31, 9. To make this bet, place a chip on the area of the racetrack labeled "Orphelins".

Voisins: a bet on a series of 17 numbers – 22, 18, 29, 7, 28, 12, 35, 3, 26, 0, 32, 15, 19, 4, 21, 2, 25. To make this bet, place a chip on the area of the racetrack labeled "Voisins".

BET TYPES

You may bet on any of the following:

- Red: Pays 1 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. A Red bet is a bet on all 18 red numbers. To make a Red bet, place a chip on the area labeled with red.

- Black: Pays 1 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. A Black bet is a bet on all 18 black numbers. To make a Black bet, place a chip on the area labeled with black.

- Even number: Pays 1 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. An Even number bet is a bet on all 18 even numbers, excluding 0 and 00 (when playing on double zero roulette). To make an even bet, place a chip on the area labeled "EVEN".

- Odd number: Pays 1 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. An Odd number bet is a bet on all 18 odd numbers. To make an odd bet, place a chip on the area labeled "ODD".

- 1-18: numbers 1 to 18. Pays 1 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. 1-18 bet is a bet on the first 18 numbers excluding 0 and 00 (when playing on double zero roulette). To make a 1-18 bet, place a chip on the area labeled "1-18".

- 19-36: numbers 19 to 36. Pays 1 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. 19-36 bet is a bet on the last 18 numbers. To make a 19-36 bet, place a chip on the area labeled "19-36".

- Column: a bet on a line of 12 numbers. Pays 2 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a Column bet, place a chip on one of the 3 areas labeled "2-1".

- Dozen: a bet on 12 numbers (4 rows of 3 numbers).

- 1st dozen - the first sequence of 12 consecutive numbers. Pays 2 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a 1st dozen bet, place a chip on the area labeled "1st 12".

- 2nd dozen - the second sequence of 12 consecutive numbers. Pays 2 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a 2nd dozen bet, place a chip on the area labeled "2nd 12".

- 3rd dozen - the third sequence of 12 consecutive numbers. Pays 2 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a 3rd dozen bet, place a chip on the area labeled "3rd 12".

- Six line: a bet on six consecutive numbers consisting of two street bets (two rows of three numbers). Pays 5 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a Six line bet, place a chip on the common corner of the two rows that contain the first (smallest) number in each of the rows being selected.

- Corner: a bet on four numbers that meet in one corner. Pays 8 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a Corner bet, place a chip on the common corner of the four boxes containing the numbers you wish to bet on. On single zero roulette game you can also make a Corner bet on 0, 1, 2, 3 by placing a chip on the common corner of 0 and the row of 1, 2, 3.

- Street: a bet on a row of 3 numbers. Pays 11 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a Street bet, place a chip on the line at the start (smallest number) of the row you wish to bet on.

- Trio: when playing a single zero roulette game - a three-way split between the 0 and two other numbers. When playing double zero roulette game (game that contains a 0 and a 00 sector) - a three-way split between the 0 and/or 00 and adjacent numbers. Pays 11 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a Trio bet on a single zero roulette game, place a chip on the common corner of the boxes containing the numbers 0, 1 and 2 or 0, 2 and 3. To make a Trio bet on a double zero roulette game, place a chip on the common corner of the boxes containing the numbers 0, 1 and 2 or 00, 2 and 3, or 0, 00 and 2.

- Split: a bet placed between adjoining numbers (bet on the border between the two cells). Pays 17 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a Split bet, place a chip on the line between any 2 adjoining numbers, except for 0 and 2 or 00 and 2 when playing double zero roulette.

- Straight: a bet placed on a single number. Pays 35 to 1. Max bet \$5,000.00. To make a Straight bet, place a chip on a number displayed on the table.

For the best gaming experience, use of the latest version of software is recommended.

Malfunction voids all pays and plays.
