

## About Backcourt Blackjack

Backcourt Blackjack is a classic Blackjack table game with the addition of a unique Backcourt Blackjack (BB) side bet which allows you to win up to 21 times your bet.

### General

Play up to 3 boxes on mobile portrait view and up to 5 boxes on landscape or desktop.

The dice bonus for the Backcourt Blackjack side bet consists of 2 dice. If the dice show the same number after a roll, the side bet is multiplied.

Win amount is based on the total bet amount and type of bet placed.

Total bet is the sum of all bets placed for the game.

The payouts for all market types are fixed and the payout amount is based on the total bet.

Malfunction voids all pays and plays.

### Side Bet Features

If the dealer or player has a Blackjack, and player has placed the side bet, 2 dice are rolled.

If both dice do not show the same number the bet is paid at 7/1.

If both dice match then side bet will be paid 21/1.

### How to play

Backcourt Blackjack is played with up to 5 boxes and 6 standard decks of 52 cards (Jokers not included).

Cards are shuffled and drawn one by one for each game.

The objective is to beat the Dealer. The player must create a hand that outscores the dealer, but not exceed 21.

The value of a hand is the sum of the values of all cards in the hand.

The value of each card is as follows:

Cards 2-10 are valued as indicated

Face cards (J, Q and K) are all valued at 10 points

A blackjack hand is one that contains only an A and any 10 point value card (10, J, Q or K)

An A counts as 1 or 11. If scoring an 11 would cause the hand to exceed 21 (too many), an A is counted as 1.

The game takes place against computerised dealer.

The dealer is dealt a "hole card" - a card which has been dealt face down - and an open card.

The "hole card" is revealed once all players' hands have been played and the dealer's hand is played out as per the rules.

A tie between the player and the house is displayed as PUSH, this results in a player's bet being returned.

Depending upon the player's hand the following actions will be displayed: Hit, Stand, Split, Double down as per the game rules.

The player can Stand at any time. No more cards are dealt for this hand.

The player can Hit to receive an extra card. The player can be dealt a maximum of seven cards up to the total of 21, anything greater than 21 results in "Too many".

Players can Double Down on any first two cards. A second bet, equal to the first one is made and only one more card is dealt. There are no further cards available on Double Down.

Double down is also offered on each Split hand, apart from splitting two Aces, as only 1 card is dealt when splitting Aces.

Once Split is selected, a second bet - equal to the first one - is made on the split hand

An extra card is dealt on each split hand. Only one split is allowed on a single hand.

Hands of 21 automatically stand.

No surrender or insurance is available on this game.

The dealer hits up to 16, and stands on 17, soft 17 included.

When the dealer's hands is completed, the results are displayed.

## **Table Limits**

### **Hand bet:**

Min.: \$0.10

Max.: \$20,000.00

### **Side Bet:**

Min.: \$0.10

Max.: \$3,000.00

Any game in progress for more than 35 days will be cancelled, and the corresponding bet will be refunded.

Winnings are paid according to the payout table. Notwithstanding the foregoing, should an upper winning limit be specified, said limit will prevail. However, the upper limit may be unreachable depending on the game's bet configurations.

Some features, such as Buy Bonus, Buy Pass, Fortune Spins, Feature Buy, Turbo and Speed Spins, some other configurable features and additional bets may not be available.
